In this dissertation, I show how two opposing online gaming communities—the far-right /r/KotakuInAction and the leftist /r/GamerGhazi—utilize the social media platform Reddit’s democratic voting interface to shape debates about American racism and sexism. Drawing from intersectionality and masculinity studies, I show how Reddit’s site design, algorithm, and business model suppress feminist and anti-racist activism and provide fertile nesting ground for far-right extremism. Given the built-in challenges of forming feminist and anti-racist alliances on Reddit, together with the platform’s ubiquity as a primary news source for millions of Americans, I assert that Reddit fosters far-right extremism and reflects, as well as reproduces, American social inequalities.
